I want to thank you for the gracious donation of baby formula for the population who need it the most in our county. We conduct Women, Infant, and Children (WIC) Clinics through the Health Department. Clients enrolled in this program are also connected to other resources in our county - one of those connections being Partial to Girls clients.

The Rotary's generous donation of formula will be used to help Partial to Girls clients who are also enrolled in WIC. Both programs assist women and children to obtain essential items and services, nutrition information, assistance for their babies, etc. We received approximately \$2000 worth of formula delivered to the Health Department.
